The student attempted 4 questions as per the paper and showed a better than average understanding of the questions.

The student did not engage in discussion of the primary documents but had a clear understanding of the scholarly arguments pertaining to all four questions and clearly articulated his arguments. It was evident that the student had been equipped with the needed historical data and that an adequate preparation had clearly been undertaken. Of the four questions attempted the one pertaining to Australian Christianity was the weakest both in the material presented the answer and an understanding of the issues. A fuller answer to this question may have rewarded the student with the HD received in CH 201.

The student showed an adequate understanding of the issues raised in the questions attempted. There was evidence of very good preparation and equipping with the needed historical data. However, the answers were inclined to stray from the question and covered periods of time which were not strictly asked for in the scope of the question. The answer to the question pertaining to Australian Christianity was particularly vague and almost cost the C which was awarded.
