

## SCALE OF FEES 2010

### **MDiv/ GradDipDiv**

---

Tuition fee per credit point (except LA001–004) Domestic students: \$365  
International students: \$365

LA001–004 tuition fee per credit point Domestic students \$330  
International students \$330

The total fee covers registration, administration and examination fees and includes an ACT fee component of \$33 per credit point, with the exception of LA001-004 which is \$27 per credit point.

### **MA (Theol) / MA (Min) / MA (ChrSt)**

---

**Tuition fee per credit point** Domestic students: \$240  
International students: \$326.75

The total fee covers registration, administration and examination fees and includes an ACT fee component of \$27 per credit point.

### **MTh**

---

An ACT research masters degree is deemed to be a 64 credit point course of study.

Normal period of candidature is 2 years full time or 4 years part time.

Domestic candidates will be charged a tuition fee of \$240 per credit point or \$15,360 over the period of candidature, to be levied in semester increments of \$3,840 for full time and \$1,920 for part time students. Domestic students who complete in less than two years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$15,360. That outstanding balance cannot be claimed on FEE-HELP but must be paid upfront.

International candidates will be charged a tuition fee of \$326.75 per credit point or \$20,912 over the period of candidature, to be levied in semester increments of \$5,228 for full time and \$2,614 for part time students. International students who complete in less than two years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$20,912.

The total fee covers registration, administration, supervision and examination fees and includes an ACT fee component of \$43 per credit point.

### **DMin**

---

The DMin is deemed to be a 96 credit point course of study.

Normal period of candidature is 3 years full time or 6 years part time.

**Tuition fee per credit point** Domestic students: \$240  
International students: \$326.75

#### **Project phase:**

Domestic candidates will be charged a tuition fee of \$240 per credit point or \$23,040 (\$7,680 p.a.) over the three-year period of candidature, to be levied in semester increments of \$3,840 for full time and \$1,920 for part time students. Domestic students who complete in less than three years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$23,040. That outstanding balance cannot be claimed on FEE-HELP but must be paid upfront.

International candidates will be charged a tuition fee of \$326.75 per credit point or \$31,368 (\$10,456 p.a.) over the three-year period of candidature, to be levied in semester increments of \$5,228 for full time and \$2,614 for part time students. International students who complete in less than three years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$31,368.

The total fee covers registration, administration, supervision and examination fees and includes an ACT fee component of \$43 per credit point.

The project preparation fee is paid to colleges and is equivalent to the fee levied for one 8 cp coursework unit at the candidate's sponsoring institution.

## ThD

---

The ThD is deemed to be a 96 credit point course of study.

*Normal* period of candidature is 3 years full time or 6 years part time (although the minimum candidature is two years).

Domestic student will be charged a tuition fee of \$240 per credit point and international student will be charged a tuition fee of \$326.75 per credit point.

Full time domestic students pay \$3,840 per semester and part time domestic students pay \$1,920 per semester.

Domestic students who complete in less than three years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$23,040. That outstanding balance cannot be claimed on FEE-HELP but must be paid upfront.

Full time international students pay \$5,228 per semester and part time international students pay \$2,614 per semester. International students who complete in less than three years will be required to pay any outstanding balance to bring the total fee to \$31,368.

The above fees cover registration, administration, supervision and examination fees and include an ACT fee component of \$43 per credit point.

**Qualifying essay fee** (for candidates transferring to the ThD) \$130

**Reading of candidate's published works** (when submitted during course of candidature) fee upon application

## Miscellaneous

---

### Extension of candidature:

For those candidates who are granted extensions of candidature beyond the normal maximum time limit, fees continue to be levied as above. This means that candidates will pay more than the normal total fee listed if they are unable to complete their program within the first period of candidature allocated.

**Appeals Fee** Half the normal ACT administrative fee  
(only levied in cases where a student has already passed the unit but is seeking to improve their grade)
